

# Profiles of Integrated Care: Centerpoint Co-Located Primary Care Clinic



## Description

Centerpoint Health provides outpatient counseling; case management; and supportive, crisis, and prevention services to children and adults in Hamilton County. Centerpoint has five locations, each providing integrated services on-site. The agency serves approximately 9,000 people, with over half receiving psychiatric services. Centerpoint Health partners with a community health center to provide primary care services on-site at two Centerpoint locations. Centerpoint's clients become patients of and develop a relationship with the community health center and can receive primary care services at Centerpoint or the community health center's locations.

## Operational Resources

A primary care physician and nurse practitioner from the Healthcare Connection, Inc.—the community health center partner—deliver services. The Healthcare Connection takes care of billing, administration, and supervision of the physician and nurse. Centerpoint set up primary care clinic offices and examination rooms in the two locations.

## Financial Resources

This project was funded through a three-year grant from The Health Foundation of Greater Cincinnati and through in-kind support from Centerpoint. By the end of the grant period, Centerpoint expects the project to be sustained through billing for services. Because the community health center is a federally qualified health center (FQHC), the center receives the enriched Medicaid payment rate for eligible services.
