Description

Community Behavioral Health's Community First Pharmacy is owned and operated by the Fort Hamilton Healthcare Corporation and is located within the Community Behavioral Health's Hamilton office. It is a full-service pharmacy used by clients and staff of Community Behavioral Health. This resource improves coordination of care and decreases the amount of nonproductive clinical staff time.

Operational Resources

The pharmacy has two FTE pharmacists who coordinate with Community Behavioral Health's doctor and nurses. Community Behavioral Health provides space for the pharmacy within its Hamilton office.

Financial Resources

Money from insurance plans, patient copayments, and self-pay patients helps sustain the pharmacy. Community Behavioral Health continues to work on sustainability.
