

Profiles of Integrated Care: Community Health Center & Family Practice



Description

Community Health Center & Family Practice provides a comprehensive array of healthcare services to 3,450 people with compulsive and addictive behaviors each year. Among its services are:

- a full range of alcohol and other drug addiction services, except inpatient hospital detoxification;
- Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) for Opiate Addiction;
- treatment for health conditions related to addiction, such as hepatitis B and C, sexually-transmitted diseases, and HIV/AIDS;
- family practice health care services;
- medical and laboratory services;
- laser services, such as tattoo and brown spot removal;
- employment and vocational services;
- transitional and permanent housing; and
- child care.

Operational Resources

The Community Health Center employs 67.91 FTE direct staff, 42.14 FTE support staff, and 15 FTE administrative staff for alcohol and other drug addiction services. In addition, the Family Practice division employs 7.74 FTE; the housing division employs 5.13 FTE; and CommStaff, a full-service employment agency that the Center runs, employs 2.97 FTE.

Outpatient services are provided within four buildings in a central campus area and totals 72,000 square feet.

Financial Resources

Start-up funding sources included grants, cash reserves, private donations, fundraisers, and bank loans. Ongoing funding comes from Medicaid, Medicare, Ohio Housing Finance Agency, insurance, self pay, various governmental funding sources, foundations, grants, annual fundraisers, and a development campaign.

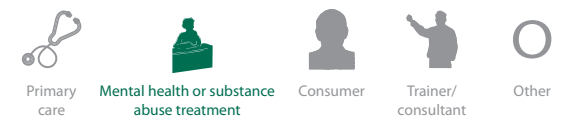
