- ✓ Review overarching “major fiscal policy barriers”
 1. **“The uninsured”**- eligibility is only part of the problem
 2. **New services are needed** for integrated care- and they aren’t reimbursed
 3. **Medical interventions aren’t reimbursed at high enough rates** for people with complex medical and engagement needs
 4. **There are separate Medicaid** and related systems
 5. **Implementation/ Start-up** costs money and staff resources
