

Profiles of Integrated Care: Harbor Behavioral Healthcare Primary Care Services



Description

Harbor Behavioral Healthcare provides mental health and substance use disorder treatment services to children and adults. It recently added primary care and developmental services to one of its community mental health center locations. These services are available to Harbor's clients as well as to the community at large in Northwest Ohio.

Operational Resources

Harbor has one family practice physician (who also serves as the Medical Director) and three developmental/behavioral health pediatricians, one of whom also provides primary care to children. Two of the pediatricians have full practices; the other two doctors are newer to the organization and are still building their practices.

The primary care is provided in a single location within one of Harbor's centers. The developmental/behavioral services are located in another center in a different location. This center focuses on youth and also happens to be within a hospital campus.

Financial Resources

Harbor funded the start-up of its primary care services through its own internal resources. It is currently funded through private insurance, Medicaid, and its self-pay patients.
