Description

Jules Rosen, MD, of the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center presents four 30-minute modules on mental health and substance use issues of older adults. This series is targeted at primary care and internal medicine physicians who treat older adults. Other health care professionals, consumers, and families are also welcome to view the modules. The topics are:

- Module 1: Treatment of Depression in Late Life
- Module 2: Dementia
- Module 3: Delirium: Acute Confusional State
- Module 4: Substance Abuse in Late Life

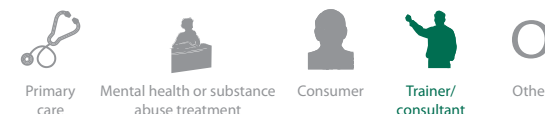
